Details on each event below

June 4 - Homeschool Grades 4-8 Bike (Trout Lake Area)

Time & Meeting Location: 8 am - 3:45-4 pm at the Hwy M & Hwy N Parking Lot

Day of Biking and exploring the paved bike trail from Hwy M & N Parking Lot to North Trout Lake Campground.

There will be stops along the way to North Trout Lake. We will be stopping after 1.5 miles at the mouth of the Allequash Creek, after 3.3 miles at the north end of South Trout Lake, after 4.6 miles at Cathedral Point and then finally to North Trout Lake at mile marker 6.75. We will eat lunch at North Trout and play some games. If there is time we will hike the 1 mile loop of the North Trout Lake trail. Our way back to the M & N parking lot will be direct with a mileage of 4.5 with stops on the trail as needed. Total mileage will be 11.25 miles. Don't let that discourage you as it will be spread out over the course of the day.

June 18 - Grades 4-5 Bike & Hike (Trout Lake Area)

Time & Meeting Location: 8 am - 3:45-4 pm at the Hwy M & Hwy N Parking Lot

Day of Biking and exploring the paved bike trail from Hwy M & N Parking Lot to North Trout Lake Campground. (If you have already gotten to participate in this adventure on June 4th please let some others have the opportunity to participate. We can add you on the overflow list in case less than 8 sign up.)

There will be stops along the way to North Trout Lake. We will be stopping after 1.5 miles at the mouth of the Allequash Creek, after 3.3 miles at the north end of South Trout Lake, after 4.6 miles at Cathedral Point and then finally to North Trout Lake at mile marker 6.75. We will eat lunch at North Trout and play some games. If there is time we will hike the 1 mile loop of the North Trout Lake trail. Day of biking local mountain bike trails. We will first explore the Zip Line Mountain Bike Trails in Minocqua. Then we will be exploring the Raven Trail where there is a paved trail and rouged single track trail. We will explore a little of both trails. If you do not have a bike let us know and we can get one for you.
